SOLDIERSTRONG IN COLLABORATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS TRAINS CLINICIANS TO DEPLOY BRAVEMIND VIRTUAL REALITY THERAPY







In a groundbreaking collaboration with the Department of Veterans Affairs, SoldierStrong recently facilitated training sessions at the Ernest Childers VA in Tulsa, Oklahoma and the Biloxi VA Medical Center in Biloxi, Mississippi to train a group of the federal agency's clinicians from across the country to deploy the innovative BraveMind virtual reality therapy to treat veterans experiencing post-traumatic stress (PTS).

In an effort to contribute to the reduction to the current rate of **17 veteran suicides per day**, SoldierStrong has donated 30 BraveMind systems to VA facilities since the fall of 2019. Through a process known as prolonged exposure therapy, users are able to recreate the scenes of traumatic wartime memories in the VR headset which over time de-conditions emotional responses to those memories in a controlled environment.

VETERANS END UP SHARING THINGS WITH THEIR CLINICIANS THAT THEY MIGHT NOT HAVE OTHERWISE SHARED WITH THEM, ALL DUE TO THE FACT THAT THEY'RE IMMERSED IN THE VIRTUAL ENVIRONMENT THAT REALLY BRINGS BACK MEMORIES THAT MIGHT NOT HAVE OTHERWISE BEEN PRESENT IN THEIR SESSIONS WITH THEIR CLINICIANS."

In fact, BraveMind has proven so effective that 65% of users in a study noted that their PTS symptoms lessened or disappeared completely after completing the therapy. SoldierStrong's ultimate mission is to ensure that BraveMind is accessible in every VA facility in the nation for every veteran who needs it.


