STANDING TALL: HOW SOLDIERSTRONG'S PARTNERSHIP WITH EKSO BIONICS IS TRANSFORMING VETERANS' LIVES

When Senior Chief Jesus Fernando Ruiz, a Navy Veteran, was injured in the line of duty he thought the world he knew was over. Like many veterans facing life-changing injuries, Fernando believed he would have to adapt to a completely different way of life.

But thanks to exoskeletons developed by Ekso Bionics - wearable robotic suits which aid injured and paralyzed individuals in walking again - Fernando's story is one of hope and resilience. SoldierStrong's pioneering partnership to bring Ekso Bionics' exoskeletons to veterans nationwide has allowed even more veterans to experience that same hope and resilience as Fernando.

"I felt normal again," Fernando recalls about the first time he used the Ekso Bionics exoskeleton. "Like I used to before my injury."

SoldierStrong is proud to have donated 30 of Ekso Bionics' cutting-edge exoskeleton suits, we've dubbed "SoldierSuits," to Veterans Affairs medical facilities and individual veterans since 2013.

"We're honored to join forces with Ekso Bionics to provide revolutionary technologies and innovative advancements to improve the lives of veterans and their families at no cost," said Dr. Chris Meek, Co-Founder and Chairman of SoldierStrong. "Exoskeletons bring much needed rehabilitation support to our valued veterans enabling them to



achieve the mobility freedom that they deserve."

The innovative engineering of Ekso Bionics' Indego Personal exoskeleton makes it particularly valuable for veterans like Fernando, who uses it not just for rehabilitation but for daily activities that restore dignity and independence.

"The biggest purpose for it is rehab," Fernando explains. "I have used it to stand up in front of the microwave and wash my dishes. I can now reach my cabinets and the plates."

Perhaps the most powerful testament to the technology's

impact comes from Fernando's personal life. The 51-yearold Navy veteran, who served from 1993 to 2016, found that the exoskeleton didn't just restore his mobility - it restored precious moments with his family.

"I have a five-year-old son, and the first time he saw me walking with the exoskeleton he said, 'Hey, Papi, you can walk, Papi,' and I was like, 'Yes!' Seeing him all excited just drives me. Being able to walk again pushes me toward doing more and more."

It's about restoring dignity, independence, and hope to those who have sacrificed so much for our country. It's about a father being able to stand tall in front of his son. It's about veterans reclaiming not just their mobility, but their future.

As Fernando's experience demonstrates, sometimes the most profound transformations begin with a single step - and thanks to SoldierStrong's partnership with Ekso Bionics, that step is made possible for veterans across the country.

MULTISTACK HOSTS ANNUAL CHARITY GOLF CLASSIC TO BENEFIT SOLDIERSTRONG



SOLDIERSTRONG TO DONATE 31ST BRAVEMIND VIRTUAL REALITY SYSTEM



Due to the generosity of valued supporters from across the country throughout 2025, SoldierStrong is honored to announce the donation of our 31st BraveMind virtual reality system to treat post-traumatic stress (PTS) in post-9/11 veterans. The donation will be made to Confidential Care, a private psychiatric and mental health agency where clinicians specialize in working with disabled veterans, in Wasilla, Alaska.

The United States loses 17 veterans a day to suicide, making the BraveMind virtual reality systems we donate a critical option for those veterans seeking mental health services. This will be the first time that the BraveMind technology will be available to veterans in the great state of Alaska.



SOLDIERSTRONG, GIER PRODUCTIONS ANNOUNCE "THE HEROISM AND RESILIENCY OF 9/11" DOCUMENTARY

SoldierStrong, in partnership with award-winning filmmaker Michael Gier, is developing a powerful documentary titled "The Heroism and Resiliency of 9/11," scheduled for release in 2026. Narrated by Gary Sinise, the film tells the story of 9/11 through personal accounts from first responders, survivors, public officials, and everyday heroes who rose in the aftermath. The result promises to be more than a retelling of tragedy; it's a tribute to the human spirit, the bravery of those who acted, and the resilience that followed.

SoldierStrong co-founder Dr. Chris Meek, who himself was present at Ground Zero on 9/11, first proposed the idea after witnessing how so many in our country were seeking meaning and healing in the years since. Gier, known for his thoughtful, emotionally resonant films, traveled across the U.S. to interview key figures like former U.S. Chief of Staff Andy Card, Port Authority Officer Will Jimeno, and former CIA Director Leon Panetta and to capture reenactments that bring these stories to life. This is a project we believe will resonate deeply with veterans, supporters, and all who believe in honoring sacrifice with purpose.
